Hello Nautilus Community! This will be my last newsletter president's message since I will be relinquishing the president's gavel after the election of officers and board members during the reunion business meeting in September.

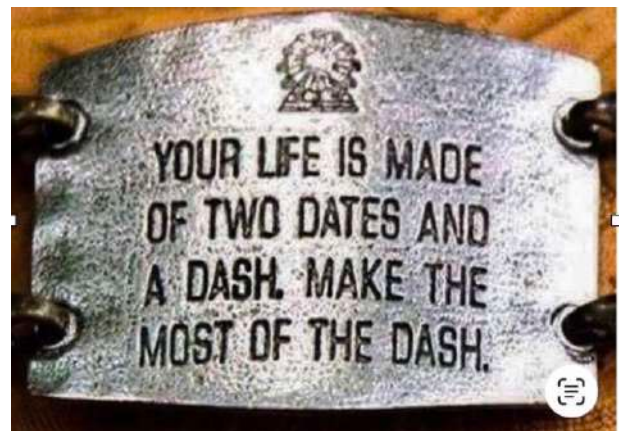

It all started in Hawaii

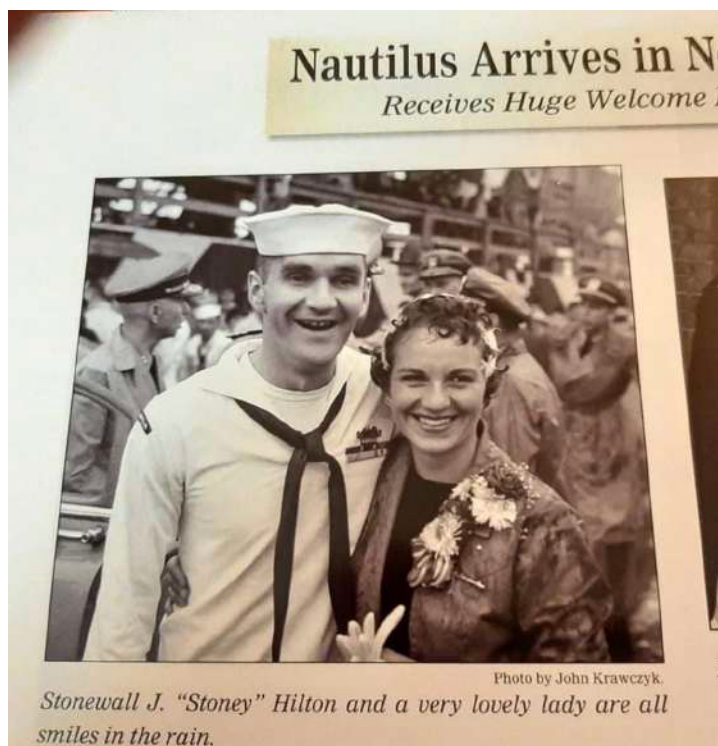

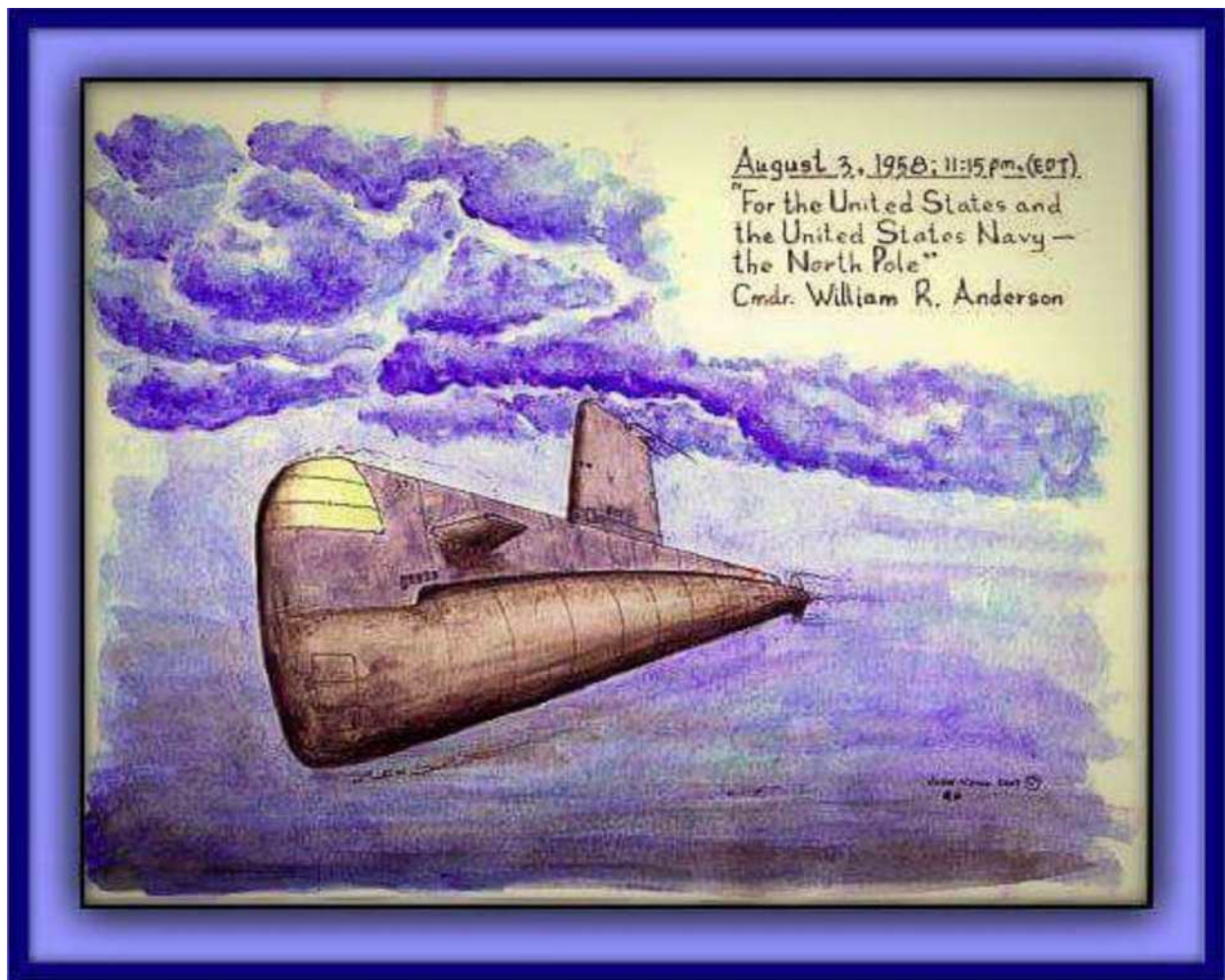
